## **PUBLIC FORUM RULES/GUIDELINES**

- 1. The Moderator/Co-Moderator will enable the "waiting area/lobby" for the Zoom meeting and allow candidates/public/students in the main forum area as they join.
- 2. The Moderator will make welcome remarks and introduce Co-Moderator and candidates.
- 3. The Moderator/Co-Moderator will act as the timekeeper
- 4. The Moderator/Co-Moderator shall inform all participants about the time limits and rules
  - a. All participants will be muted by the Moderator/Co-Moderator as soon as they enter the forum.
  - b. Moderator/co-moderator shall announce to all participants that they must keep their microphone muted.
  - The Moderator/Co-Moderator shall announce to all participants that the LACCD Standards of Student Conduct will apply throughout the duration of the candidate forum (Standards of Student Conduct)
  - d. If any of the participants (public/students/candidates) uses any means of technology to interrupt the normal operation of the forum, the Moderator/Co-Moderator has the right to remove them from the forum (constant interruptions, speaking out of order, trolling, "zoom-bombing", threatening behavior, etc.) and in accordance with the <u>Standards of Student</u> <u>Conduct</u>.
  - e. Participants may use the Chat function if they wish to communicate.
  - f. Each candidate has 3-5 minutes for opening statements.
  - g. After the opening statements are concluded the floor will be open for Q and A.
  - h. All questions must be submitted via the Chat function and must be in writing.
  - i. The Moderator/Co-Moderator will ask the questions in the order they are received.
  - j. It is optional if the Moderator/Co-Moderator allows for questions to be submitted orally and via the use of the microphone
  - k. The Moderator/Co-Moderator shall ask frequently if all participants if the audio/video's quality is adequate (comments can be directed to the Chat function).
