FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the prerequisites for applying to the Registered Nursing program at LATTC?

Human Anatomy (with lab component), Human Physiology (with lab component), Microbiology (with lab component), English 101, Psychology 41 (Life-Span), Psychology 1 (Introductory Psychology). We do not accept online labs for science prerequisite courses. Please Note: Due to Covid-19, we will accept online labs taken during Spring 2020-Summer 2023.

Do you have a recency for your sciences?

We do not have a recency requirement for prerequisites; however, instructors will expect students to know the most current information.

Do you have a repeat rule for prerequisites courses?

Students are allowed one negative grade repeat (D, F, INC, NP) for Anatomy, Physiology, and Microbiology. **Please Note:** This is one repeat for all three courses combined (not one repeat for each). We do not count W's or retaking a science course that has a positive grade (C or higher) as repeats.

Is there a minimum GPA required for prerequisites?

Students must have a combined GPA of 2.5 or higher in Anatomy, Physiology and Microbiology. Students must also have a 2.5 or higher GPA in overall coursework. There are NO exceptions!

Is there a deadline to apply to the Registered Nursing Program?

Applicants are accepted on an ongoing basis. There are no deadlines.

Does your admissions process include a point system or lottery?

No. Students are admitted on a first-come, first-serve basis as long as admission requirements are met.

How do I apply to the program?

First Step: Complete all prerequisites

Second Step: Attend a mandatory Information Session **Third Step:** Attend a mandatory Verification Workshop

• In order to attend the workshop students must have posted grades for prerequisite courses (no In Progress prereqs accepted) and a TEAS 7.0 score of 62% or higher

Fourth Step: Complete an application after the prerequisites and passing TEAS score have been verified by the Health Sciences Pathway Counselors (via the Verification Workshop).

What is the passing score for the TEAS exam?

Students must score a 62% or higher. If a student does not pass the first attempt, he/she must score a 62% or higher in each category on the second attempt. We do not accept more than 2 attempts.

What TEAS exam will you accept?

We accept TEAS 7.0 (released June, 3 2022). We no longer accept ATI TEAS (TEAS 6.0). No exceptions. TEAS must be taken with an in-person proctor. We do not accept TEAS exams with an online proctor.

How much is the Registered Nursing Program?

The 2022-2023 cost per unit for LACCD courses is \$46 (resident fee). LATTC's RN program consist of 37.5 units, totaling \$1,725. This does not include cost for nursing uniforms, books, nursing kit, student health fee, general education courses needed for degree or transfer, etc.

How long is the Registered Nursing Program?

The Nursing Program is two years (four semesters/Fall and Spring).

How long is the wait for the Registered Nursing Program?

Four to Six Semesters (2-3 years). Semesters include Fall and Spring; Summer and Winter terms are not counted.

Do you have an LVN to RN program?

Yes. The current wait for the LVN to RN program is 3-5 years.

Do you have any partnerships with universities offering a BSN degree?

LATTC currently has a collaborative with CSULA, CSUN, CSUF, CSULB, CSUDH, GCU, and APU for an accelerated ADN-BSN degree. <u>You must be actively enrolled in our ADN program to apply.</u>
